This newsletter covers the time between July and September 2007.

## **Work Progress**

A lot of the work produced during this time has consisted of system integration, requirement specification, revising, ranking and concretizing of use cases. The target groups of QVIZ have been defined more closely. The administrative ontology is now covering more than 50 000 units in the target areas Sweden, Estonia and Great Britain. As the project has but 7 months left the work is concentrating on exploitation and productification of the QVIZ system by amongs other things depicting content providers, and arranging meetings and cooperation with national archives in Scotland, Hungary and Finland. Two workpackages have come to an end, WP2 and 4. Concrete developments of functions are being made on the faceted browser, a search instrument that is closely linked to the map and its timeline and th social bookmarking which is an archival client tool that can be implemented into different archival resources which will facilitate linking between the CoP:s and the archives.
